ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Internationally trained professionals who:

- Are residents of Ontario
- Permanent Residents, Naturalized Canadian Citizens, Refugee Claimants, Convention Refugees, Approved Provincial nominee under the Ontario Immigrant Nominee Program, Visitors under Emergency Travel measures enacted by the federal government (e.g., CUAET), and residents with temporary work permits who have received permanent residency approval in principle from IRCC.
- Are currently unemployed or underemployed.
- Do not hold a Canadian post-secondary credential.
- Have an international education equivalent to a Canadian degree or diploma in IT, computer programming, software development, or a related field.
- Have prior work experience outside Canada in IT, programming, software development, or related areas.
- Canadian Language Benchmark Level 6 (Minimum)
