Internationally trained professionals who:

- Are residents of Ontario
- Permanent Residents, Naturalized Canadian Citizens, Refugee Claimants, Convention Refugees, Approved Provincial nominee under the Ontario Immigrant Nominee Program, Visitors under Emergency Travel measures enacted by the federal government (e.g., CUAET), and residents with temporary work permits who have received permanent residency approval in principle from IRCC.
- Have educational qualifications outside of Canada with a minimum equivalency to a Canadian degree or diploma
- Have previous work experience outside of Canada in repairing household and business electronic devices, including audio and video systems, computers and peripherals, office equipment, and other consumer electronics.
- Canadian Language Benchmark Level 6
