Eligibility

You may qualify for IES if you are:

- Of legal working age (15 years old and older). Individuals who are between the ages of 15-18 must be legally excused from school
- A resident of Ontario • A Canadian citizen, permanent resident, refugee, or newcomer with a valid work permit
- Unemployed or working less than 20 hours per week
