As part of the program, participants will also receive 10 Health & Safety certifications, including Globally Harmonized WHIMIS, Working at Heights, and Introduction to Hand Tools.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Age 18-29
- Have one of the following statuses:
 - Canadian Citizen
 - Permanent Resident
- Not enrolled in full-time school
- Facing barriers to employment
- Have access to a computer/smartphone or device with a reliable internet to complete some virtual training.
